Important Information

- Webservice is Multilingual
- The webservice allows you to post with Custom Classification / Subclassification
- The webservice uses ID's for the core fields below which will be provided by JXT or Please use the **DefaultList** method to get all the latest values:
 - **Classification / Subclassification**
 - **Country / Location / Area**
 - **Worktype**
 - **Advertiser Job template logo**
 - **Job template**
- **Webservice Logs**
 - In the admin - Clients will be able to access their webservice logs.
 - In the admin - the core fields can be exported in excel format, which can be forwarded to the Multiposter.
- Currently below fields don't exist in the platform and which will be added soon.
 1. We need to add **Company Name** to Job
 2. **Sector** needs to be created by WL
 3. **Referral Fee** - HasReferralFee, ReferralUrl, Amount.

- **Webservice Requests**

1. The Webservices accepts both REST and SOAP.

- **REST** (XML) – “Representational state transfer” – *we recommend REST and examples below are in REST format.*
- **SOAP** (1.1 and 1.2) – “Simple Object Access Protocol”

2. Multiposter will be able to Default List, Get Consultant, Archive, Post Jobs (New and Update by Reference no.) by advertiser.
